Last rites for the Reverend Ernest C. Driskell, retired Methodist minister, were held Wednesday afternoon, March 28th, at the Moore Memorial Methodist Church with the Rev. W. P. Bailey, pastor, and the Rev. A. Y. Brown of Greenwood. Interment was in Oakwood cemetery under the direction of Lee Funeral Home.

Serving as pallbearers were A. P. Holmes, Frank Fisher, M. C. Caldwell, W. H. Shaffer, Jamie Rogers, Willie Costilow, G. J. Johnson and Guy Coleman.

The Rev. Mr. Driskell, who was born December 5, 1883, in Hardinsburg, Ky., was educated in Davis public school, Kingswood College in Kingswood, Ky., and Seashore Divinity School in Biloxi, Miss. He preached his first sermon at Ephesus Presbyterian Church near Harned, Ky., in April, 1910, and was licensed at Mt. Zion Church near Kingswood July 21, 1910.

It was during four years service as a missionary-evangelist that he preached his first sermon in Mississippi in the Baptist Church at Webb, in December 1911. It was also during that period he met Miss Lois Hyde, whom he married at Sumner, Miss., Jan. 29, 1913.

He was licensed to preach at Tutwiler, Miss., April 17, 1914 and appointed to serve the Valley Mission until November, 1917. He was ordained a deacon in 1918 and an elder in 1922.

Since 1917, the Rev. Mr. Driskell has served the following charges: Greenwood Springs, Buena Vista, Fulton, Calhoun City, Lambert, Late Cormorant, Vaiden, Pickens, Marks, Byhalia and Winona.

He kept a record of his ministry; the place, date and text of every sermon, date of every marriage and funeral and list of every member received and dismissed.

Rev. Driskell served as secretary of the North Mississippi Conference for 18 years and since his retirement in June 1953 he had served the Winona Circuit until his recent illness. He had also served on the board of missions and board of evangelism. He had formerly been a member of the Rotary and Lions clubs.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Lois Hyde Driskell of Winona; four daughters, Mrs. Carroll Johnson of Monroe, La., Mrs. Jack Abbott, Jr., of Montgomery, Ala., Mrs. Chris George of Winona and Mrs. James Laughter of Hernando, and four grandchildren.

Kentucky Virginia Driskell, Garland's daughter, said he was raised by his Aunt Acrattia (known as Cratter) Pate.

In 1960, Garland was hospitalized for lung cancer but died suddenly of a heart attack while in the hospital. He and Ruth had been married for 40 years. Garland worked for Serv-A-Tool out of Dayton, OH until 2 weeks before his death.

Garland had no middle name. When he was born, his mother wanted to name him Garland Oscar Driskell but then realized his initials would be G.O.D. She felt that was sacrilegious so gave him no middle name at all.

Notes for Ruth Marie Schwartz:

Ruth and her sister Mabel were known as "fun loving" girls. She grew up in Elkville, IL and surrounding area and married an Edly Plummer** right out of school. This was an ill-fated marriage that lasted only 1 year. Shortly after, Ruth met Garland Driskell of KY, a traveling salesman. After 3 weeks of courtship, they were married in Pinkneyville in 1920. She moved to Owensboro with Garland where there daughter was born and a year later, moved to Norwood, Ohio (Cincinnati) where they remained. After Virginia married, and with some assistance from Charles, they owned their first home on Hilltop Lane in Wyoming, Ohio. Ruth worked for a while at the Shillito's Department store, now Lazarus and as a sales person for the Rookwood Pottery in Cincinnati. She never learned to drive..having been scared badly by a truck driver while trying to learn. After Garland's death, she took an apartment in Mt. Healthy and remained there for 25 years. A stroke forced her to give up her apartment and move in for a short time with Ginny and Charles. She had a bout with intestinal cancer for which she had surgery and it never recurred. Her doctor did recommend, for hers and Ginny's sake, that she be put in a nursing home. It was an unpleasant decision but she went to live at Lebanon Health Care Center in Lebanon, OH. Ginny made the long trip there 2-3 times a week for 7 years. Ruth died there on Sept. 13, 1989. She was not able to communicate well in those later years and although we knew she didn't like it there, it was hard to tell just how she felt or if she understood why it had to be. A sad time in our lives. She did get to meet her great grandson Adam Putt. We took him to visit several times before her death. She would hold him on her lap and say, "mine, mine". I'm sorry she never knew Emily..she would have had a field day with her beautiful blond hair. One of Boo's (as we called her) favorite things was to curl and dress her little girls...first Ginny and then Gayle when she was little. Gayle did not, being such a tomboy, appreciate her efforts. ** Journal written by Eva Lucy Schwartz and in the possession of William Homer "Duke" Castleton (on loan to Gayle Putt) states that Ruth Schwartz married Edly Thornton, not Plummer, on May 1, 1915. Eva Lucy was the aunt of Ruth Schwartz. Thornton is not correct..another niece of Lucy married a Thornton. In a later
